Other Tips

Shoes – Authentic Scottish “**Ghillie Brogue**” lace up shoes are essentially dress shoes and not great for walking parades. Also \$99.00. Go with nice sneakers or comfortable rubber soled dress shoes. Be prepared for blisters if not wearing sneakers or black sandals.

Belts – Kilt belts (thick) are expensive though look very impressive. They run about \$70 with a nice big buckle. You can also go with any nice thick/plain belt that will fit around your kilt.

Bead Belt – Holds beads and is sold at The Bead Barn in Tampa. Just a long leather belt with many grommets for hanging hooks with beads. This can be worn with the kilt belt or just by itself.

Sporran – It's nice to have pockets though it's not essential. Shop around for a cheap one since it will see little use. eBay has tons of them or any Scottish site.
